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## Objectives of IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell)

- **Enhancement and Integration:** To develop a system for conscious, consistent, and continuous effort to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution.
- **Internalization and Institutionalization:** To promote various measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through adopting internal quality culture and implementing of best practices.
- **Standardization and Benchmarking:** To establish benchmarks for various academic and other activities of the institute and ensure their periodic monitoring and improvement.
- **Stakeholder Engagement:** To include all stakeholders in the quality enhancement process and to create a participatory and autonomous work culture.

## Mission of IQAC

- **Quality Initiatives:** To initiate, execute and supervise various academic activities that are necessary to improve the quality of education and its deliverables.
- **Continuous Improvement:** To provide a sound basis for decision-making to improve institutional functioning and to act as a dynamic system for quality changes in HEIs.
- **Documentation and Reporting:** To ensure timely and efficient execution of academic, administrative and financial activities, including proper documentation and reporting to the respective bodies.
- **Faculty Development:** To enhance faculty teaching and research capabilities through organized workshops, seminars, and other professional development programs.
- **Promoting a learner centric environment** for students and staff that foster the mission and vision of the Institution.

## Vision of IQAC

- The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), established as per NAAC guidelines, aim to work towards quality sustenance and enhancement of the academic and administrative performance of the Institution.
- **Sustainable Quality Assurance:** To develop a quality system for conscious, consistent, and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institutions.
- **Quality Culture:** To instill a quality culture within the institution to support the holistic development of students and staff, and to meet the demands of a rapidly changing educational environment.

## Functions of IQAC

1. Facilitation of a student-centric environment: Creating an environment conducive to quality education and facilitating participatory teaching and learning processes. Encouraging the use of modern teaching tools viz. ICT and other innovative pedagogical techniques.
2. Feedback Collection and Analysis: Collecting feedback from students, parents, and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes. Analyzing feedback to identify areas for improvement and implementing necessary changes.
3. Development and Application of Quality Benchmarks: Establishing and maintaining quality benchmarks for various academic and administrative activities. Ensuring that these benchmarks are regularly reviewed and updated.
4. Dissemination of Information on Quality Parameters: Sharing information on various quality parameters through organizing workshops, seminars, and conferences
5. Documentation of All Activities: Documenting the various programs and activities on quality improvement. Maintaining a record of various events and developments organized by IQAC and other cells
6. Coordination of Quality-Related Activities: Coordinating the quality-related activities of the institution. Identifying and implementing best practices within the institution.
7. Development of a Quality Culture: Cultivating a culture of quality within the institution by involving all stakeholders in quality initiatives. Encouraging continuous self-assessment and self-improvement among faculty and staff.
8. Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR): Preparing and submitting the AQAR to NAAC based on the prescribed guidelines and parameters in time and consolidating the report.
9. Acting as a Nodal Agency: Ensuring timely, efficient and progressive performance of academic, administrative and financial tasks. Liaising with external quality assurance agencies, regulatory authorities, and other stakeholders.
10. Capacity Building and Professional Development: Organizing training and development programs for faculty and staff to enhance their competencies. Promoting research, consultancy, and other academic activities to improve institutional quality.
